
Search Types and Criteria

The following describes the different search options and the criteria the user can use to narrow their search

- **Inspection Provider**
 - Inspection Location ID
 - Inspection Provider Name
 - Town
 - Post Code
- **Inspection Provider Assessor**
 - Inspection Provider Assessor ID
 - Name
- **Safe Loading Pass**
 - Safe Loading Pass serial number (in the form XXXXXXXX-YY)
 - Batch number (in the form XXXXXXXX)
 - Vehicle registration or VIN number.
- **Stake Holder Organisation**
 - Stakeholder Organisation ID
 - Name
 - Town
 - Post Code

- **User**
 - Email address
 - Name
 - User Type
- **Vehicle**
 - VIN Number
 - Registration

Note: Search types are restricted by user type, only those the user is authorised to use will be displayed.


Once the user has selected a search type, they can then enter some search criteria in the search box. The search box is an 'omni-search' and will search for matches across all the criteria stated above at the same time and return results accordingly.

The results of the search will be displayed on cards which the user can click on to view further information.

Filtering and Sorting

The user can narrow their search results, either by being more specific in the search box, or by telling the application specifically what to search on. This is done by setting the 'Filter By:'

By default, **Filter By** is set to all, meaning all search criteria will be considered.
